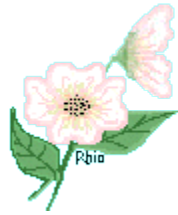

*This scholarship will be awarded to Student(s) who will be graduating from Jennings County High School and will be pursuing a degree in the field of Special Education*

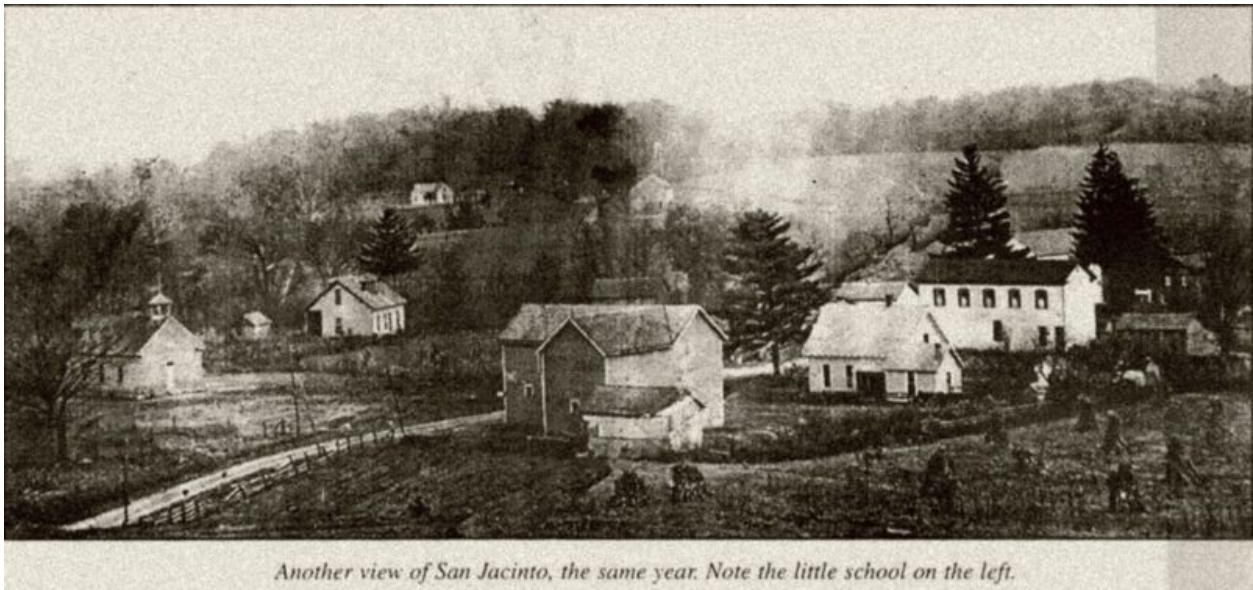
## Memories of Bigger Township Community Scholarship
