## Checked Ball draws record attendance

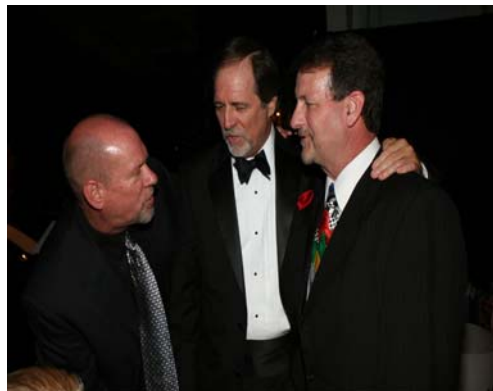

## Ira Charitable Rollover Reinstated

On Friday, October 3, 2008, Congress voted to retroactively extend the IRA Charitable Rollover provision from January 1, 2005, through December 31, 2009.

The IRA charitable rollover, as originally enacted by the Pension Protection Act of 2006, provides a tax advantage for retirement savers who are 70 1/2 years or older. If you transfer a contribution of up to \$100,000 from your IRA directly to a qualified public charity, such as The Jennings County Community Foundation you can count the full amount toward your required minimum IRA distribution this year and avoid the income tax on the amount contributed, as well as potential future estate taxes. In addition, the transfer is not subject to the charitable deduction limit of 50% of your adjusted gross income.

### To Qualify as an IRA Charitable Rollover

- You must be 70 1/2 years or older at the time of the gift.
- You may distribute up to \$100,000 to a qualified public charity. A husband and wife, who each have a separate IRA, may contribute \$100,000 each for a combined charitable distribution of \$200,000.
- Transfers must be made directly from your IRA administrator to the charity.
- The gift amount will be excluded from your taxable gross income (provided the distribution would be otherwise taxable).
- The IRA gift will be counted toward the minimum distribution requirements for IRAs.
- Distributions can only be made from traditional IRAs or Roth IRAs.

### Important Limitations

- Transfers may not be made from 403(b), 401 (k), pension, or other retirement plans.
- Contributions can be made to eligible public charities, but not to donor-advised funds, supporting organizations, private non-operating foundations, charitable lead trust, and life income plans, such as charitable remainder trust, pooled income funds and charitable gift annuities.
